

American Chemical Society Georgia Section Women in Chemistry Scholarship

The American Chemical Society Women Chemistry Committee for the local Georgia section announces the **2017 ACS Georgia Section Women in Chemistry Scholarship**. An award of \$500 will be presented to one undergraduate **AND** one graduate female majoring in the chemical sciences.

In order to be eligible for the ACS Georgia Section Women in Chemistry Scholarship, a woman must have all of the following qualifications:

- Be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program within the ACS Georgia Section 45 region, majoring in chemistry or a related chemical science. See map below for eligible regions.
- 2. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 3. Demonstrate the qualities of a future leader in the chemical sciences



TO APPLY:

- 1. Complete application form
- 2. Submit official electronic transcripts from relevant colleges and universities attended by the candidate to georgiawcc@gmail.com
- 3. Submit one (1) letter of reference from a qualified person who can attest to the candidate's leadership in the chemical sciences. Candidate should arrange for the letter to be sent electronically to georgiawcc@gmail.com. Letters should be sent independently of the candidate's application packet prior to the application deadline.

All required information must be received by the WCC by Midnight October 31st, 2017.
